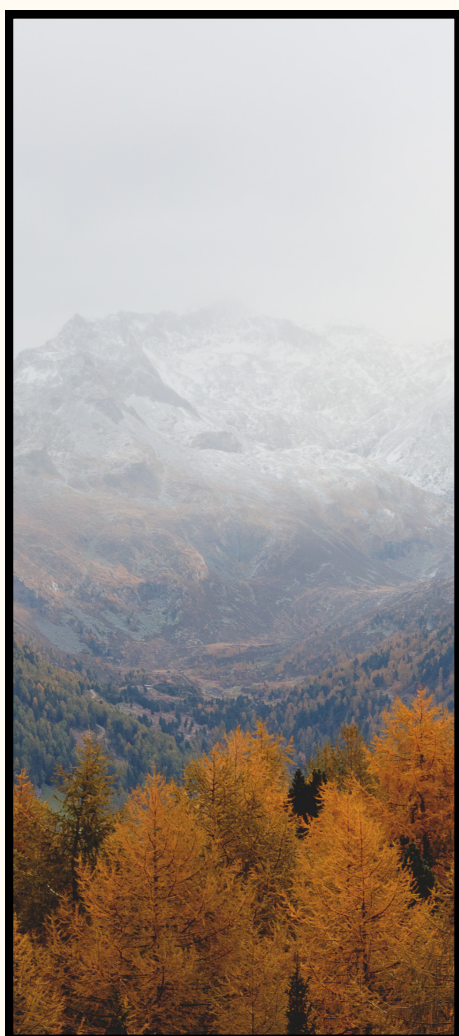

Every year, Teacher on Special Assignment Christina Packard organizes and hosts Coffee with a Cop through the ASB class at Mariposa Elementary School. This is the 4th year this event has been up and running.

When asked about the program Mrs. Packard shared, "The goal is to build a positive relationship with local law enforcement for students. It's fun for kids to interact with law enforcement in a positive way. We start organizing this the first or second week of school. We reach out to local businesses to support them with donations. Our ASB students do a lot of work. Even after the event, they are sending out thank you letters to the departments that participated. It's a great event for them to show appreciation and gain leadership skills."

LOCAL DASHBOARD AVAILABLE NOW!

The California Dashboard became the data focus in the state of CA in 2017. This dashboard is updated yearly based on a multitude of data points. This information supports data driven decision making at the district and county level as well as provides information around site specific areas of growth and challenge. This dashboard is released once per year.

While the information is incredibly useful, it does not allow for real time information or course correction as needed. It gives us a great look at what occurred last year, but in education real time data is needed to determine next steps for student success and growth.

To meet this need, MCUSD's Educational Services team has worked to create a District Dashboard that is updated monthly to ensure that we have real time data to support our students.

This data includes:

- Benchmark data for ELA and Math
- Literacy Data
- Chronic Absentism Data
- Suspension Data

In addition to a district dashboard, your school site also has a newly created dashboard containing site specific data. Ask your principal for more information! Is there data you would like to see added? Let your site administrator know!
