Status, Investments, and Next Steps

- Updated interconnecting phone system
 - Allows for our paging system, phone system and notification system to talk to each other.
- "Revolution" Notification Platform
 - Enabling rapid alerting to inform and protect people located on or off premise.
 - o Real-Time Alerts Any Time, Anywhere
 - Flexible Notification Activation
 - Controlled Access
 - Streamlined Communication

- Partnership with Central California
 Communications who will be conducting internal audit on functionality of alarm and public announcement systems
- Partnership with OpTerra Energy Solutions to improve exterior lighting
- Staff is researching effectiveness of cameras systems for school safety
- Staff is researching Security Lock Box options for emergency personnel at each site
- APEX Bus Driver Training provided to staff
- Designated staff members trained as trainers for Crisis Prevention Intervention

Policy and Procedures

- Emergency Preparedness Plan being updated
- Schools provide schedule for all drills
- Elementary Lockdown Drills are provided in line with state requirements.
- High School Drills: Conducted once per semester
 - Fire, Earthquake, and Lockdown

- Visitors are required to check in and out
- Volunteers completed and approved through background check process
- Sheriff's deputies are requested when there are high foot traffic events on campus, i.e. Sporting Events, Graduations, etc.
